These will generally be no more than 750 square metres per occupancy. a) Sensitive uses such as places of worship, schools, and residential care facilities are not permitted; and b) Licensed child care centres are permitted as an ancillary use, provided the primary use is not noxious. Entrances and outdoor play areas should locate away from roads and loading and parking areas. 	In Volume 2A of the Official Plan, Policy 2) b) of the Riverside South Secondary Plan is updated to exclude childcare as an accessory use within an employment area. This aligns with 2.8.2 3. b), which prohibits public service facilities, even as ancillary uses.
