

GENERAL NOTES FOR GRADING:

1. IT SHALL BE THE BUILDER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT GRADING AROUND HYDRANTS, TRANSFORMERS, AND UTILITY PEDESTALS, ETC., MEET CURRENT CITY OF OTTAWA, HYDRO AND UTILITY COMPANY REQUIREMENTS.
2. ALL GROUND SURFACES SHALL BE EVENLY GRADED WITHOUT PONDING AREAS AND WITHOUT LOW POINTS EXCEPT WHERE APPROVED SWALE OR CATCH BASIN OUTLETS ARE PROVIDED.
3. GRADE IN GRASSED AREAS WILL BE BETWEEN 2% TO 7%. GRADES IN EXCESS OF 7% WILL REQUIRE A MAXIMUM 3:1 TERRACING.
4. NO EXCESS DRAINAGE, DURING OR AFTER CONSTRUCTION, TO BE DIRECTED TOWARDS NEIGHBORING PROPERTIES.
5. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE EXISTING DRAINAGE PATTERNS TO BE MAINTAINED.
6. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE POSITIVE DRAINAGE AWAY FROM FOUNDATION.
7. CONTRACTOR TO ENSURE NO ALTERATION TO EXISTING GRADES ON THE PROPERTY LINES.
8. UNDERSIDE OF FOOTING TO BE MINIMUM 1.5m BELOW FINISHED GRADE, OR INSULATION TO BE PROVIDED. TOP OF FOUNDATION TO BE MAINTAINED 0.15m ABOVE FINISHED GRADE.

10. EXISTING ELEVATIONS ALONG PROPERTY LINE ARE TO BE MAINTAINED.
