The New Zoning By-law - Draft 2 staff report and 16 supporting documents were received by the Joint Planning and Housing and Agriculture and Rural Affairs Committee on March 31, 2024 and City Council on April 16, 2024. At both the Joint Committee and Council meetings, Members of Council provided direction to staff through several motions and directions. Appendix 1 – Overview of Motions and Directions on <u>DevApps</u> provides an overview of these motions and directions and the additional options to be prepared for consultation through the spring and summer.

The New Zoning By-law team is seeking feedback on the Draft 2 provisions and updated zoning map. This commenting period will run from **May 2, 2025 to June 30, 2025**. Comments submitted during this time will be considered by the project team and any resultant changes will be incorporated into Draft 3 of the by-law. Comments received following June 30 will continue to be reviewed and considered, but it may not be possible to incorporate all feedback into the final provisions.
