SATISFACTION OF ALL CITY REQUIREMENTS The Owner agrees, by entering into an agreement to satisfy all requirements, financial and otherwise, of the City of Ottawa, including but not limited to, the phasing of the plan for registration, the provision of roads, installation of services and utilities, and drainage. CONVEYANCE OF ACCESS EASEMENT TO CITY The Owner shall grant to the City a blanket easement over the lands, with the right and licence of free, uninterrupted, unimpeded and unobstructed access to the City to enter on and to pass at any and all times, on, over, along and upon the lands with or without vehicles, supplies, machinery and equipment for all purposes necessary or convenient to construct, maintain, repair and replace the Private Watermains, Private Service Posts and fire hydrants at the Owner's expense. The Owner acknowledges and agrees that notwithstanding the rights granted to the City under the grant of easement, the Owner remains responsible at all times for the maintenance, inspection, alteration, repair, replacement and reconstruction of the utility in the said lands during their term of use. PERMISSION TO ENTER The Owner shall at all times allow the City to enter the lands with machinery, materials, vehicles and equipment necessary to maintain, inspect, alter and repair the Private Watermains, hydrants and Water Plant located on the lands. The Owner acknowledges and agrees that notwithstanding the rights granted to the City, the Owner remains responsible at all times for the maintenance, inspection, alteration, repair, replacement and reconstruction of the utility in the said lands during the term of use. MAINTENANCE OF PRIVATE SERVICES The Owner acknowledges and agrees that the Water Plant and sewer service within the lands is a private system, including Private Services and sewer services and appurtenances, and the Owner acknowledges and agrees that it is responsible for the operation, maintenance and/or replacement, in perpetuity, of the Private Services and sewer system, including the Private Watermains, private hydrants, private sanitary and storm sewer infrastructure (collectively the "private system") which are located on the lands and that the Owner will retain copies of all the associated Work and maintenance contracts, and make said contracts available for inspection upon demand by the City. Further, the Owner acknowledges and agrees to have a Professional Engineer, licensed in the Province of Ontario, conduct regular inspections of the water system and sewer system, which includes a leak detection survey at least every five (5) years and a video of the sanitary sewer system to check for major water infiltration into the private system. Copies of the inspection reports and videos shall be provided to the General Manager, Infrastructure and Water Services and Fire Services. The Owner further agrees to include a condition in all agreements of purchase and sale of the Subject Property, or any part thereof, requiring that all subsequent owners of condominium units and the Condominium Corporation assume and accept the obligations and responsibilities under the Private Road Agreement, which covenant shall run with the lands. The said condition shall be substantially similar to the following:
