Further to your request, Paterson Group (Paterson) conducted a Phase I - Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) Update for the aforementioned property. This report updates a Phase I ESA entitled "Phase I-Environmental Site Assessment, Vacant and Agricultural Property, 405- 425 Huntmar Drive and 3001 Palladium Drive, Ottawa, Ontario" prepared by Paterson, dated January 8, 2014 (Report: PE3146-1).

This report is intended to meet the requirements for an updated Phase I ESA, as per the MECP O.Reg 153/04, as amended. This report is to be read in conjunction with the 2014 report.

Background

The Phase I Property, currently addressed 1380 Upper Canada Street (also referred to as Block 2 of Registered Plan 4M-1627) is part of a smaller portion of the original subject property referred to in the 2014 Phase I ESA report. The Phase I Property is located on the east side of Palladium Drive, approximately 176 m north of the Campeau Drive and Palladium Drive roundabout, in the City of Ottawa, Ontario. The subject land currently exists as vacant land, situated in a general industrial zone. Neighbouring land use is also designated for general industrial use.

Previous Engineering Reports

Based on the 2014 Phase I ESA, no historical or current use of the Phase I Property identified any potential environmental concerns.

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Surrounding land use to the north, south, east and west consisted of vacant/agricultural lands, commercial, residential and a quarry, respectively. No potential environmental concerns were identified with the current use of the Phase I Study Area. A Phase II ESA was not recommended at that time.

Site Conditions

A site visit was conducted on March 3, 2020. The Phase I Property is currently vacant. No structures or utilities are present on-site. The site appears to be relatively flat and at grade with adjacent properties and Palladium Drive. The regional topography slopes downwards in an easterly direction towards Carp River.

Site drainage consists primarily of runoff to adjacent streets to catch basins. No private sewage systems or wells were observed on the subject property. No evidence of current or former railway or spur lines on the subject property was observed at the time of the site inspection.

The current configuration of the subject site has changed since the 2014 Phase I ESA, which is shown on Drawing PE4897-1 – Site Plan, attached to this report.

Updated Records Review

Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks Freedom of Information Request

An ERIS search was requested in lieu of the Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks (MECP) Freedom of Information (FOI) request as part of this Phase I-ESA.

MECP Instruments

An ERIS search was requested for information with respect to certificates of approval, permits to take water, certificates of property use or any other similar MECP issued instruments for the Phase I Property and properties within the Phase I Study Area.

According to the ERIS report, there were no Certificates of Approval (CAs) issued for the Phase I Property.

Two (2) permits to take water and an environmental compliance approval for sewage works were issued for properties located more than 180m away from the Phase I Property. Based on the nature of these permits and approvals, these reports are not considered potential environmental concerns (PCAs), and thus, are a non-issue.

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No other permits, certificates of approval or environmental compliance approvals were identified within the Phase I Study Area. A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

MECP Waste Management Records

According to the ERIS report, no waste management records were found for the Phase I Property or lands within the Phase I Study Area. A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

MECP Submissions

According to the ERIS search, there were no records pertaining to the environmental conditions of the Phase I Property or the Phase I Study Area. A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

MECP Incident Reports

According to the ERIS report, there was one environmental incident regarding the Phase I Property or lands within the Phase I Study Area. A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

MECP Brownfields Environmental Site Registry

A search of the MECP Brownfields Environmental Site Registry (ESR) was conducted as part of this assessment for the site, neighbouring properties and the general area of the site. No Records of Site Condition (RSCs) were filed for the Phase I Property or lands within the Phase I Study Area.

MECP Waste Disposal Site Inventory

The Ontario Ministry of Environment document titled "Waste Disposal Site Inventory in Ontario, 1991" was reviewed as part of the historical research. This document includes all recorded active and closed waste disposal sites, industrial manufactured gas plants and coal tar distillation plants in the Province of Ontario. There are no active or closed waste disposal sites or former manufactured gas or coal tar distillation plans within the Phase I Study Area.

ERIS Report

As previously discusses, an ERIS search was conducted for the Phase I Property and lands within the Phase I Study Area. There are no new records pertaining to the Phase I Property or lands within the Phase I Study Area. A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

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City of Ottawa Historical Land Use Inventory (HLUI)

It is our understanding that the City's database (HLUI 2005) has not been updated since the 2014 Phase I ESA, and as such, the original HLUI response remains valid as the Phase I Property remains unchanged since the 2014 Phase I ESA. Therefore, a new search request of the City of Ottawa's HLUI database has not been submitted as part of this update.

Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA)

The TSSA, Fuels Safety Branch in Toronto was contacted electronically on March 3, 2020 to inquire about current and former underground storage tanks, spills and incidents for the site and neighbouring properties. No records of underground storage tanks, spills or incidents were listed in the TSSA registry for the Phase I Property or the adjacent properties. A copy of the TSSA correspondence has been appended to this report.

The surrounding properties are occupied by a newly constructed medical office to the north, while the east, west and south are vacant lands. No potentially contaminating activities (PCAs) were identified regarding the current use of the neighbouring lands.

Update Conceptual Site Model

Based on the above noted records update and the site visit, no significant changes have been made to the Phase I Property or properties within the Phase I Study Area. No potentially contaminating activities or areas of potential environmental concern were identified as part of this Phase I ESA Update. Based on this Phase I-ESA Update, it is our opinion that a Phase II-ESA is not required for the subject site.

Statement of Limitations

This Phase I - Environmental Site Assessment Update report has been prepared in general accordance with Ontario Regulation 153/04, as amended, under the Environmental Protection Act. The conclusions presented herein are based on information gathered from a limited historical review and field inspection program. The findings of the Phase I - ESA Update are based on a review of readily available geological, historical and regulatory information and a cursory review made at the time of the field assessment.

Should any conditions be encountered at the subject site and/or historical information that differ from our findings, we request that we be notified immediately in order to allow for a reassessment.

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This report was prepared for the sole use of Govan Brown & Associates. Permission and notification from Govan Brown & Associates and Paterson will be required to release this report to any other party.





Taggart Construction Limited, Paterson Group Inc. and Robert Passmore have been fined \$5,000 each, totalling \$15,000 plus a victim fine surcharge, after pleading guilty on January 15, 2009 to violations under the Ontario Water Resources Act. Taggart Construction Limited and Paterson Group Inc. were convicted of failing to comply with a Provincial Officer Order by taking more than 50,000 litres of water per day, and Mr. Passmore was convicted of giving false or misleading information to the ministry. The parties were given six months to pay the fine. The Court heard that Taggart Construction Limited was contracted by a developer to install municipal services at a subdivision in Ottawa which required dewatering activities. After being issued a Provincial Officer Order to restrict water taking activities to below 50,000 litres per day until a permit had been obtained, Taggart hired Paterson

Group Inc. to submit an application for the permit. Taggart then pumped over 50,000 litres of water based on information provided by Paterson Group employee, Mr. Passmore, that the go ahead to pump had been given when a permit had yet to be issued. In an interview with ministry investigators, Mr. Passmore denied giving Taggart verbal approval to pump in excess of 50,000 litres per day. Taggart Construction Limited, Paterson Group Inc. and Mr. Passmore were charged following an investigation by the Ministry of the Environment's Investigations and Enforcement Branch.

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
