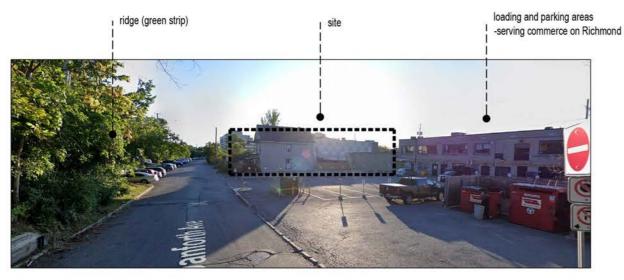
#### **Historical Context**

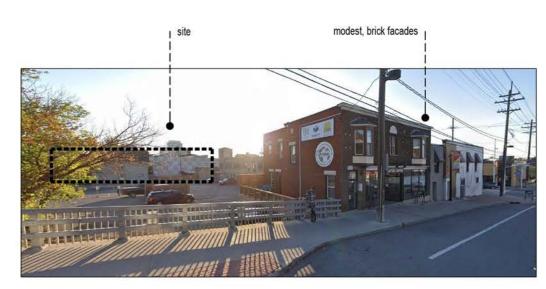
- early 19th century village suburb of Ottawa, previously named Skead's Mill after the large lumber mill in the area and as of 1900 named Westboro.
- middle class and blue collar workers from rail yards, lumber and paper mills
- the first electrical rail serviced between Ottawa and Westboro (along Byron Ave)

#### **Urban Context**

- backs onto dense commerical strip of Richmond Street
- modest, low rise, brick buildings
- at ridge of topography change at bottom of Churchill Ave hill
- rear street, loading and parking side of block
- small, eco-friendly conscious business

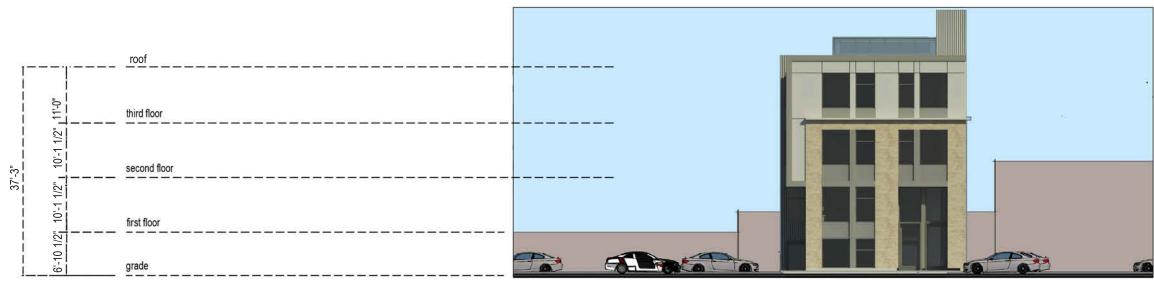

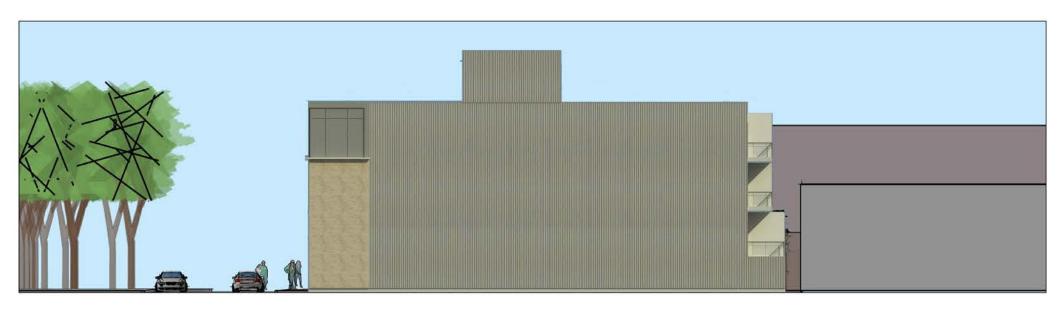

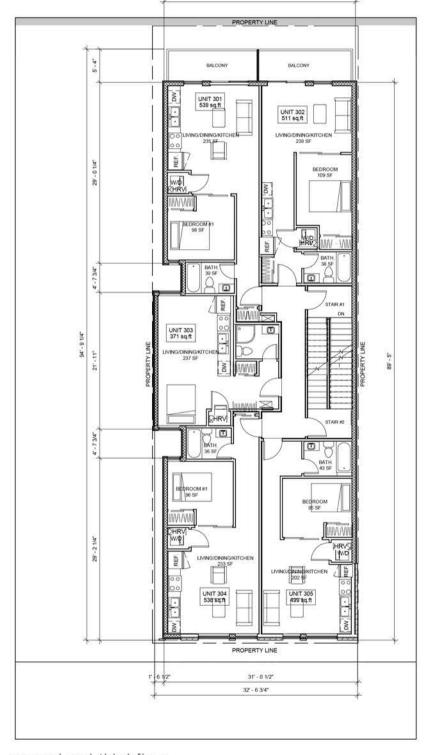


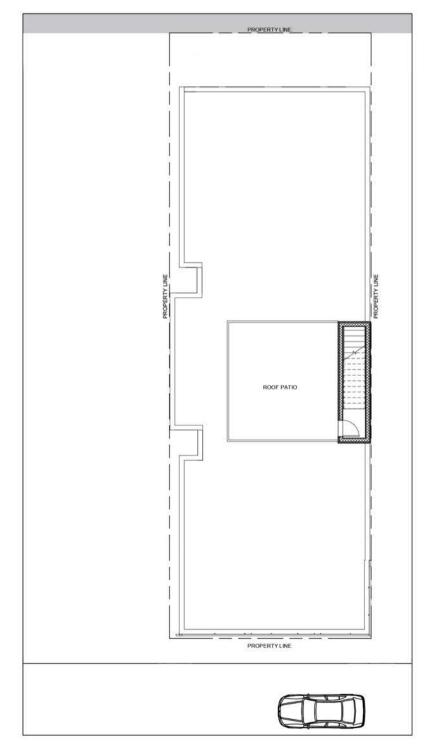


basement first floor
