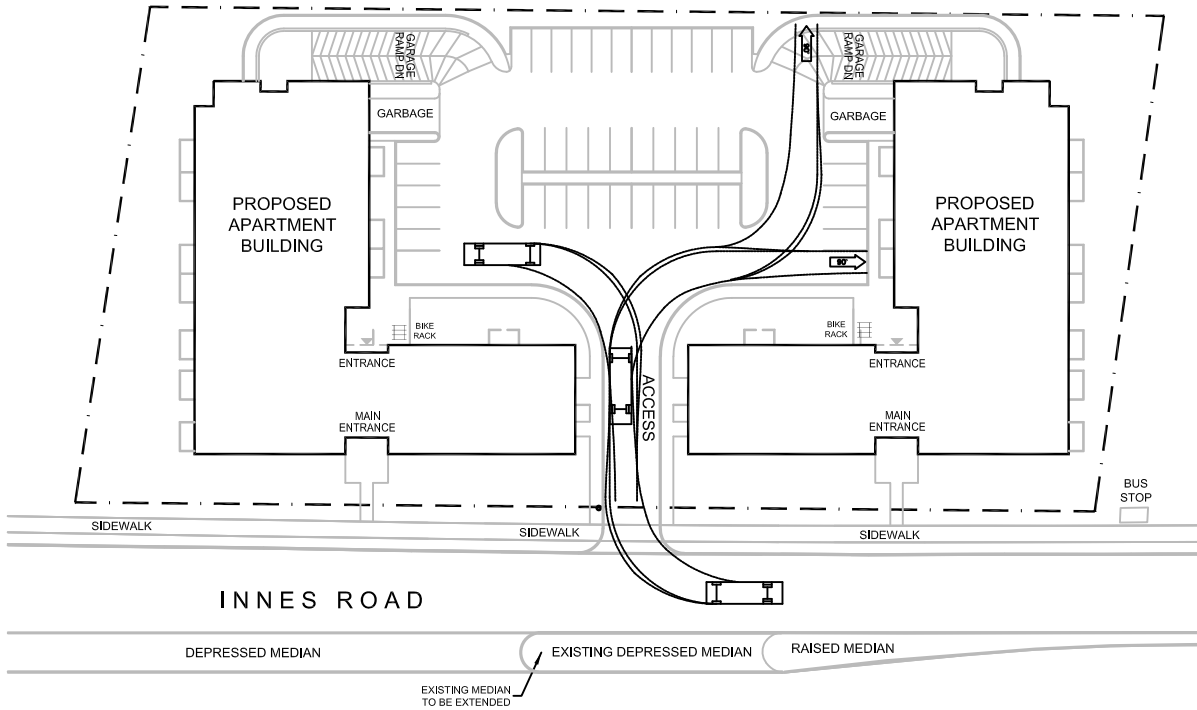
TRUCK TURNING MOVEMENT DIAGRAMS

Attached are two files, "723 Truck Turning.dwg" and "723 Truck Turning.pdf", which are drawings showing the turning movement of a truck entering and exiting the east and west buildings at 3817 and 3843 Innes Road. The turning template shows the movement for access to the interior entrance of the building for moving and delivery trucks, and garbage truck movements to the container storage sheds.

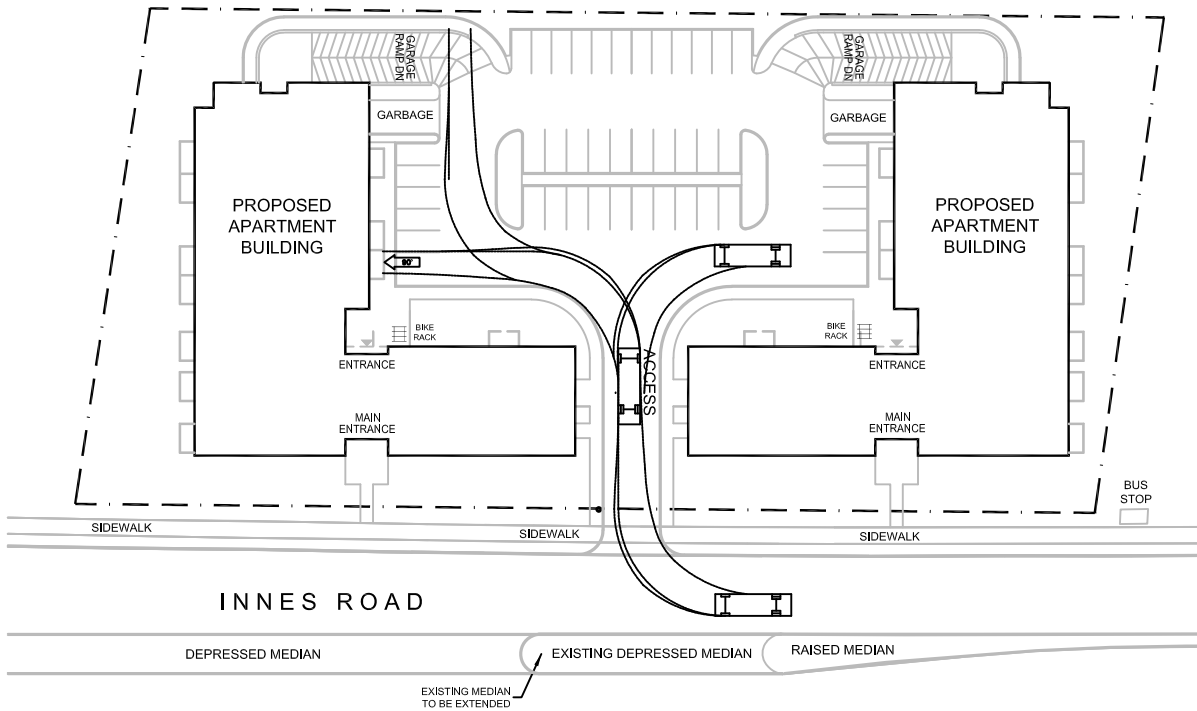
The truck turning vehicle would be a Medium Single-Unit Truck (AASHTO SU 9). This vehicle would represent delivery and service vehicles, garbage trucks, and fire pumper trucks. Trucks would enter the site from the westbound Innes Road lanes, travel to the interior building entrance or garbage storage area. Upon exiting the truck would reverse to turn around, and then proceed forward to the entrance and onto Innes Road.
