SUBJECT: Trees at “The Commons” Phase 3

1.0 INTRODUCTION

KAL Biologist Veronique Landriault conducted a site visit on October 16, 2024, to assess the presence of trees within the Phase 3 area of Glenview’s “The Commons” residential community development site. It was confirmed that no trees are located on the site. Although some trees are present beyond the property line, previous groundworks had already been completed to the site boundary in the early stages of site prep following previous site reviews, and the property is fully fenced. As such, no impacts from upcoming site development are anticipated to neighbouring trees. Images documenting current site conditions and the absence of trees are appended below.

Considering the above, a Tree Conservation Report (TCR) is not deemed to be warranted or relevant for upcoming development works.
