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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Assessment

Paterson Group was retained by Smartcentres acting on behalf of SmartREIT (Orleans II) Inc. & Mer Bleue Shopping Centres Limited to conduct a Phase I – Environmental Site Assessment (Phase I ESA) for Part of 2025 Mer Bleue Road, in the City of Ottawa, Ontario. The objective of this Phase I ESA was to research the past and current use of the site (Phase I Property) and 250m study area (Phase I Study Area) and to identify any environmental concerns with the potential to have impacted the subject property.

According to the historical research, the Phase I Property was never formally developed. The surrounding lands within the Phase I Study Area were developed with residential dwellings to the north of Innes Road circa 1991, with some commercial retail at the intersection of Innes and Mer Bleue Road. Further commercial retail development occurred in the early 2000s to the west. Several automotive dealerships were developed in the mid 2010s to the southwest of the Phase I ESA Property. The adjacent property to west was first developed 2018 with the current commercial retail plaza and associated parking. No potential environmental concerns were identified pertaining to the historical use of the Phase I Property and surrounding properties.

Presently, the Phase I Property is vacant with a seasonal storage building located at the southwest corner of the property, while the surrounding lands largely consist of a mix of residential to the north, and commercial retail properties, and poses no environmental concern to the Phase I Property.

Conclusion

Based on the findings of this assessment, it is our opinion that a Phase II – Environmental Site Assessment will not be required for the Phase I Property.



1.0 INTRODUCTION

At the request of Smartcentres acting on behalf of SmartREIT (Orleans II) Inc. & Mer Bleue Shopping Centres Limited, Paterson Group (Paterson) conducted a Phase I – Environmental Site Assessment (Phase I ESA) for Part of 2025 Mer Bleue Road, in the City of Ottawa, Ontario, (Phase I Property). The objective of this Phase I ESA has been to research the past and current use of the Phase I Property, as well as the neighbouring properties within a 250m study area (Phase I Study Area), to identify any potentially contaminating activities (PCAs) that would result in areas of potential environmental concern (APECs) on the Phase I Property.

Paterson was engaged to conduct this Phase I ESA by Ms. Leah Axt, of Smartcentres, who can be reached at 905-326-6400.

This report has been prepared specifically and solely for the above noted project which is described herein. It contains all of our findings and results of the environmental conditions at this site.

This Phase I ESA report has been prepared under the supervision of a Qualified Person, in general accordance with Ontario Regulation (O. Reg.) 153/04, as amended under the Environmental Protection Act, and CSA Z768-01 (reaffirmed 2022). The conclusions presented herein are based on information gathered from a limited historical review and field inspection program. The findings of the Phase I ESA are based on a review of readily available geological, historical, and regulatory information, as well as a cursory review made at the time of the field assessment. The historical research relies upon information supplied by others, such as local, provincial, and federal agencies, and was limited within the scope-of-work, time, and budget of the project herein.

3.0 SCOPE OF INVESTIGATION

The scope of work for this Phase I ESA is described as follows:

- Determine the historical activities occurring on the Phase I Property and in the Phase I Study Area by conducting a review of readily available records, reports, photographs, plans, mapping information, databases, and regulatory agencies;
- Investigate the existing conditions present on the Phase I Property and in the Phase I Study Area by conducting site reconnaissance;
- Conduct interviews with persons knowledgeable of current and historic operations on the Phase I Property and, if warranted, the neighbouring properties;
- Present the results of our findings in a comprehensive report in general accordance with the requirements O. Reg. 153/04, as amended under the Environmental Protection Act, and in compliance with the requirements of CSA Z768-01 (reaffirmed 2022);
- □ Provide a preliminary environmental site evaluation based on our findings;
- □ Provide preliminary remediation recommendations and further investigative work if contamination is suspected or encountered.



4.0 RECORDS REVIEW

4.1 General

Phase I ESA Study Area Determination

A radius of approximately 250m was deemed appropriate for defining the study area for this assignment, herein referred to as the Phase I Study Area. Properties located outside of the Phase I Study Area are not considered to have had the potential to impact the Phase I Property, based on their significant separation distances.

First Developed Use Determination

Based on a review of available historical information, the Phase I Property has never formally been developed.

Fire Insurance Plans

Fire Insurance Plans (FIPs) are not available for the Phase I Property and Phase I Study Area.

City of Ottawa Street Directories

City of Ottawa street directories were reviewed in approximate ten-year intervals, between 1970 and 2011, for the general area of the Phase I Property as part of this assessment. These directories contain descriptions regarding the historical land uses of properties situated within the Phase I Study Area.

During the time period reviewed, the Phase I Property and adjacent lands have been used for residential purposes with some commercial properties along Innes Road. A retail fuel outlet was identified at the intersection of Mer Bleue Road and Innes Road (4042 Innes Road), first listed in 2000 until present. Based on its separation distance (approximately 225m west) and cross-gradient orientation, it poses no environmental concern to the Phase I Property. No other concerns were identified during the directories review.

Plan of Survey

A plan of survey was not provided for the Phase I Property as part of this assessment.



Chain of Title

A chain of title was not requested for the Phase I Property as part of this assessment, since it is our opinion that no new information would be ascertained.

4.2 Environmental Source Information

National Pollutant Release Inventory

A search of the National Pollutant Release Inventory (NPRI) database was conducted as part of this assessment. This federally managed database provides various reports and tracking information relating to the release of solid, liquid, or gaseous pollutants from industrial facilities into the natural environment.

A search of this database did not identify any pollutant release records listed for the Phase I Property, or any properties situated within the Phase I Study Area.

MECP Incident Reports

A request was submitted to the MECP Freedom of Information office for information with respect to records concerning environmental incidents, orders, offences, spills, discharges of contaminants, or inspections maintained by the MECP for the Phase I Property or any of the neighbouring properties. The response from the MECP indicated that no relevant records were identified pertaining to the subject site.

MECP Instruments

A request was submitted to the MECP Freedom of Information office for information with respect to certificates of approval, permits to take water, certificates of property use, or any other similar MECP issued instruments for the Phase I Property. The response from the MECP indicated that no relevant records were identified pertaining to the subject site.

MECP Submissions

A request was submitted to the MECP Freedom of Information office for information with respect to reports related to environmental conditions for the Phase I Property. The response from the MECP indicated that no relevant records were identified pertaining to the subject site.



MECP Waste Management Records

A request was submitted to the MECP Freedom of Information office for information with respect to waste management records for the Phase I Property. The response from the MECP indicated that there was an occurrence report associated with a failed private septic bed constructed at former garage at Innes Road and Mer Bleue Road. The ministry advised to construct an additional tile bed as the first tile bed was saturated, and to use both with a junction box. No other records were identified pertaining to the subject site.

MECP Brownfields Environmental Site Registry

A search of the MECP Brownfields Environmental Site Registry was conducted as part of this assessment. This database contains publicly available information on Records of Site Condition (RSCs) filed in the Province of Ontario between 2004 and 2024. No Records of Site Condition (RSCs) were filed for the Phase I Property or any properties in the Phase I Study Area.

MECP Waste Disposal Site Inventory

The Ontario Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks document entitled, "Waste Disposal Site Inventory in Ontario, 1991" was reviewed as part of this assessment. This document includes all recorded active and closed waste disposal sites, industrial manufactured gas plants, and coal tar distillation plants situated in the Province of Ontario.

A review of this document did not identify any former waste disposal sites situated on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area.

MECP Coal Gasification Plant Inventory

The Ontario Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks document entitled, "Municipal Coal Gasification Plant Site Inventory, 1991" was reviewed as part of this assessment. This document provides a reference to the locations of former plants with respect to the Phase I Property.

A review of this document did not identify any former coal gasification plants located on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area.



Ontario PCB Waste Storage Site Inventory

The Ontario Ministry of Environment, Conservation and Parks document entitled, *"Ontario Inventory of PCB Storage Sites, April 1995"* was reviewed as part of this assessment. This document identifies all recorded active and closed PCB waste storage sites situated in the Province of Ontario.

A review of this document did not identify any former PCB waste storage sites situated within the Phase I Study Area.

Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA)

The TSSA Fuels Safety Branch in Toronto was contacted electronically on July 23, 2024, as part of this assessment, to inquire about current and former fuel storage tanks, spills, and historical incidents for the Phase I Property as well as the neighbouring properties within the Phase I Study Area. No pertinent records were found for the Phase I Property and surrounding properties.

OMNRF Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest (ANSI)

A search for ANSI sites situated within the Phase I Study Area was conducted electronically via the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry (OMNRF) website as part of this assessment.

A review of the available mapping information did not identify any ANSI sites situated on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area.

City of Ottawa Old Landfill Sites

The document prepared by Golder Associates entitled, "Old Landfill Management Strategy, Phase I - Identification of Sites, City of Ottawa", was reviewed as part of this assessment. This document identifies the details and locations of all recorded closed landfill sites situated in the City of Ottawa.

A review of this document did not identify any former landfills located on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area.

City of Ottawa Historical Land Use Inventory (HLUI) Database

As part of this assessment, a requisition form was submitted to the City of Ottawa to request information from the City's Historical Land Use Inventory (HLUI) database for any environmental records pertaining to the Phase I Property as well as any properties situated within the Phase I Study Area.



The response from the City of Ottawa, indicated that no relevant records were available pertaining to the Phase I Property.

The HLUI results identified several off-site records pertaining to properties situated within the Phase I Study Area, the majority of which have been identified through sources reviewed during the historical research portion of the Phase I ESA. Based on a review of the HLUI, no new PCAs that would result in APECs on the Phase I Property, were identified within the Phase I Study Area.

A copy of the HLUI results has been included in Appendix 2.

ERIS Database Report

A database report, prepared by ERIS (Environmental Risk Information Services Ltd.), dated July 29, 2024, was acquired and reviewed as part of this assessment. This report provides a compilation of various provincial and federal environmental related records pertaining to any properties situated within the Phase I Study Area. The complete ERIS report has been included in Appendix 2.

The ERIS report did not identify any records pertaining to the Phase I Property.

The ERIS report identified a total of 24 records for properties within the 250m radius of the Phase I Property (4 of which are previous ERIS searches).

The ERIS report identified 1 Waste Generator record for the property addressed 4100 Innes Road, approximately 225m west of the Phase I Property, associated with site preparation contractors Crepin Cartage in 2007 and 2008. Waste classes listed include waste oil and lubricants. The presence of this waste generator does not pose an environmental concern to the Phase I Property.

The ERIS report identified 3 Ontario Spill records for properties within 250m of the Phase I Property. Two pertinent spills were identified within the Phase I Study Area. One spill was the release of 400L of oily water in the parking lot of 2035 Mer Bleue Road, however, based on the cross-gradient orientation and receiving medium, the spill poses no environmental concern to the Phase I Property. The second was the spill of 250L of diesel fuel at the intersection of Innes and Wildflower, however, based on the downgradient orientation, the spill poses no environmental concern to the Phase I Property.

The ERIS report identified 6 well records within the Phase I Study Area, which are further discussed in the MECP Water Well Records section of this report.



The ERIS report identified 6 environmental compliance approvals (ECAs), environmental activity and sector registries, and certificates of approval (CAs) for properties within 250m of the Phase I Property. The records were limited to municipal and private sewage works and municipal drinking water systems, which are not considered to pose an environmental risk to the property.

A copy of the ERIS report is provided in Appendix 2.

Previous Engineering Reports

Based on a review of our files, Paterson has completed various Phase I ESAs for multiple properties situated within the Phase I Study Area. Fill was identified on the property and tested. The fill was found to be not of poor quality; therefore, the presence of the on-site fill does not pose an environmental concern to the Phase I Property. A review of these reports identified several PCAs within the vicinity of the Phase I ESA Property.

4.3 Physical Setting Sources

Historical aerial photographs of the Phase I Study Area were obtained from the National Air Photo Library and City of Ottawa (geoOttawa), and reviewed in approximate ten-year intervals, beginning with the earliest available photograph. Based on a review of these photographs, the following observations have been made:

- 1976 (geoOttawa) The Phase I Property is vacant and or used for agricultural purposes. A farmhouse can be observed to west of the Phase I Property, at the intersection of Innes Road and Mer Bleue Road. Several residential dwellings can be seen to the south along Mer Bleue Road, and along Innes Road to the northwest and northeast.
- 1991 (geoOttawa) No significant changes are apparent with respect to the Phase I Property. Lands to the north of Innes Road have been developed for residential purposes. A commercial retail plaza is observed northwest of the intersection of Innes Road and Jeanne D'Arc Boulevard. Several other commercial retail properties can be observed further to the east of the Phase I Property, along the southern half of Innes Road. Jeanne D'Arc Boulevard is observed in its current orientation. No other significant changes are apparent with respect to the surrounding lands.



- 2005 (geoOttawa) No significant changes are apparent with respect to the Phase I Property. Several commercial retail developments are currently under development to the east and west of the Phase I Property. No other significant changes are apparent with respect to the surrounding lands.
- 2014 (geoOttawa) No significant changes are apparent with respect to the Phase I Property. The farmhouse to the west of the Phase I Property is no longer present. An automotive dealership has been constructed to the southwest of the Phase I Property. No other significant changes are apparent with respect to the surrounding lands.
- 2022 (geoOttawa) No significant changes are apparent with respect to the Phase I Property. The property directly to the west and north has been developed with several commercial retail buildings. Several automotive dealerships have been constructed to the southwest of the Phase I Property, along Mer Bleue Road. No other significant changes are apparent with respect to the surrounding lands.

Copies of the aerial photographs selected for review are included in Appendix 1.

Geological Maps

Geological mapping information for the Phase I Property was obtained from The Geological Survey of Canada – Urban Geology of the National Capital Area and reviewed as part of this assessment. Based on the available mapping information, the bedrock beneath the Phase I Property generally consists of interbedded limestone and dolomite of the Gull River Formation. The surficial geology consists largely of offshore marine deposits, consisting of clay and silt, with a drift thickness ranging from approximately 5m to 25m.

Water Bodies

No water bodies are present on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area. The nearest named water body with respect to the Phase I Property is Bilberry Creek, located approximately 300m to the north.

Topographic Maps

A topographic map of the Phase I Property was obtained from the Natural Resources Canada – The Atlas of Canada website and reviewed as part of this assessment. The topographic map indicates that the general elevation of the



Phase I Property is approximately 88m above sea level, while the regional topography within the greater area is depicted as sloping downwards to the northwest, in the general direction of the Ottawa River.

An illustration of the referenced topographic map is presented on Figure 2 – Topographic Map, appended to this report.

Physiographic Maps

A physiographic map was obtained from the Natural Resources Canada – The Atlas of Canada website and reviewed as a part of this assessment. According to the publication and available mapping information, the Phase I Property is situated within the St. Lawrence Lowlands. According to the description provided: "...the lowlands are plain-like areas that were affected by the Pleistocene glaciations and are therefore covered by surficial deposits and other features associated with the ice sheets." The Phase I Property is specifically located within the Central St. Lawrence Lowland area, which is rarely more than 150m above sea level.

MECP Water Well Records

A search of the MECPs website for all drilled well records within a 250m radius of the Phase I Property was conducted as part of this assessment. The search identified 10 well records within the Phase I Study Area. These records pertain to wells installed between 1961 and 2022 and used for domestic purposes. Based on the availability of municipal water services, no drinking water wells are expected to remain in use within the Phase I Study Area.

According to the well records, the subsurface stratigraphy in the general area of the Phase I Property consists of clay. Bedrock, consisting of limestone, was generally encountered at an average depth of approximately 18m below ground surface.

A select number of the aforementioned well records have been included in Appendix 2.

5.0 INTERVIEWS

Property Owner Representative

Ms. Leah Axt, a representative of Smartcentres, was contacted electronically to respond to questions about the environmental history of the Phase I Property. Ms. Axt stated that the property is vacant and has always been. According to Ms. Axt,



the ownership is between SmartREIT (Orleans II) Inc. and Mer Bleue Shopping Centres Limited, which Mer Bleue originally purchased in 2006 and SmartREIT purchasing a percentage in 2015. Ms. Axt was unaware of any environmental concerns regarding the current or historical activities of the Phase I Property or any other neighbouring properties.

6.0 SITE RECONNAISSANCE

6.1 General Requirements

A site inspection was conducted for the Phase I Property on July 23, 2024, between 4:00PM and 5:00PM. Weather conditions were partly cloudy, with a temperature of approximately 27°C. Mr. Joshua Dempsey, from the Environmental Department of Paterson Group, conducted the inspection.

In addition to the Phase I Property, the uses of neighbouring properties within the Phase I Study Area were also assessed at the time of the site inspection.

6.2 Specific Observations at the Phase I Property

Site Description

The Phase I Property is currently vacant, with a seasonal salt/grit storage building along the southwest corner of the property. The remainder of the property consists of landscaped areas.

The site topography is relatively flat with the exception of a drainage ditch along the northern limits of the property. The regional topography appears to slope down towards the north, in the general direction the Ottawa River. The Phase I Property is considered to be at grade with respect to the neighbouring streets.

Water drainage on the Phase I Property occurs primarily via infiltration within the grassed area, as well as via a drainage ditch along the northern half of the Phase I Property.

No ponded water, stressed vegetation, surficial staining, or any other indications of potential sub-surface contamination were observed on the Phase I Property at time of the site inspection.

A depiction of the Phase I Property is illustrated on Drawing PE6469-1 – Site Plan, in the Figures section of this report.



Buildings and Structures

At the time of the site inspection, a small seasonal salt/grit storage building was observed at the southwestern property limits. No other buildings or structures were present on the property, at the time of the site inspection. A depiction of the Phase I Property is illustrated on Drawing PE6469-1 – Site Plan in the Figures section of this report.

Potential Environmental Concerns

□ Fuels and Chemical Storage

No above ground fuel storage tanks (ASTs), or evidence indicating the presence of any underground fuel storage tanks (USTs) were observed on the exterior of the Phase I Property.

□ Hazardous Materials and Unidentified Substances

No hazardous materials, unidentified substances, spills, surficial staining, abnormal odours, stressed vegetation, or any other indications of potential subsurface contamination were observed on the exterior of the Phase I Property.

D Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) and Transformer Oil

No electrical transformers or any other potential sources of PCBs or transformer oil were identified on the exterior of the Phase I Property.

□ Waste Management

No waste is currently being generated on the Phase I Property.

Neighbouring Properties

At the time of the site inspection, a survey of the neighbouring properties was conducted from publicly accessible roadways.

Land use adjacent to the Phase I Property was observed as follows:

- *North:* Commercial retail building, followed by Innes Road;
- *East:* Noella Leclair Road, followed by vacant land;
- *South:* Roger-Pharand Street, followed by vacant land;



West: Commercial retail plaza, followed by Mer Bleue Road.

No potential environmental concerns were identified with respect to the current use of the adjacent properties.

The neighbouring land use within the Phase I Study Area is depicted on Drawing PE6469-2 – Surrounding Land Use Plan, in the Figures section of this report.

6.3 Soil Characterization Investigation

A preliminary due diligence soil characterization investigation was conducted in August of 2024 in conjunction with a geotechnical investigation. A total of 12 boreholes and 8 test pits were advanced as part of the investigation to assess the soil and the fill that was encountered on site.

The soils encountered across the site generally consisted of topsoil, fill and silty clay over glacial till. The fill material encountered in the boreholes and test pits across the Phase I Property was that of reworked native material from the redevelopment of the neighbouring property. Boreholes were advanced to a depth of 2.8-6.6m below grade and terminated at practical refusal. Test pits were excavated to a depth of 1.5-3.2m below grade and terminated within the native clay layer.

All soil samples collected were subjected to a preliminary screening procedure, which included visual screening for colour and evidence of deleterious materials. No apparent deleterious substances or any visual or olfactory signs of potential contamination were observed in the samples collected during the field program.

Seven fill and three native samples were submitted for analysis of benzene, toluene, ethylbenzene and xylenes (BTEX), petroleum hydrocarbons (PHCs, Fractions F1 to F4), and metals. Two fill samples were submitted for analysis of EC and SAR.

Analytical results were compared to MECP Table 3 Commercial standards considered to be applicable for on-site use. All test data was found to comply with MECP Table 3 Commercial standards, with the exception of vanadium across the site and EC in sample TP8-24-G1. Naturally elevated vanadium is widely present in clays across the Ottawa area, at concentrations similar to that identified and is not considered to be a contaminant. As for the identified EC exceedance, the soil can be beneficially reused on-site, permitted it is placed in an area where the soil will be affected by the same chemicals as a result of continued application of a



substance for the safety of vehicular or pedestrian traffic under conditions of snow or ice.

7.0 REVIEW AND EVALUATION OF INFORMATION

7.1 Land Use History

Based on a review of available historical information, the land use history of the Phase I Property is summarized below in Table 1.

Potentially Contaminating Activities (PCAs)

No PCAs were identified on the Phase I ESA Property. Six PCAs were identified within the Phase I Study Area, three of which are associated with automotive service garages located to the southwest of the Phase I ESA Property. A former service garage was located off-site on the southeast side of the intersection of Innes Road and Mer Bleue Road. A retail fuel outlet is located on the southwest side of the intersection of Innes Road and Mer Bleue Road and Mer Bleue Road and Mer Bleue Road. One former fuel spill was identified at the intersection Innes Road and Wildflower Drive. No other PCAs were identified within the Phase I ESA Study Area.

Areas of Potential Environmental Concern (APECs)

Based on the down- or cross-gradient orientation, and separation distances of the identified PCAs, they are not considered to represent APECs on the Phase I Property.

Contaminants of Potential Concern (CPCs)

No contaminants of potential concern were identified since no APECs were identified on the Phase I Property.



7.2 Conceptual Site Model

Geological and Hydrogeological Setting

Based on the available mapping information, the bedrock beneath the Phase I Property generally consists of interbedded limestone and dolomite of the Gull River Formation. The surficial geology consists largely of offshore marine sediments, consisting of clay and silt, with a drift thickness ranging from approximately 5m to 25m.

Water Bodies and Areas of Natural and Scientific Interest

No water bodies or areas of natural and scientific interest are present on the Phase I Property or within the Phase I Study Area.

The nearest named water body with respect to the Phase I Property is Bilberry Creek, located approximately 300m to the north.

Drinking Water Wells

Based on the availability of municipal water services, no drinking water wells are expected to remain in use within the Phase I Study Area.

Existing Buildings and Structures

The Phase I Property is currently not occupied any buildings. A PVC drainage pipe is present along the northern portion of the property, feeding into a drainage ditch along the northern frontage.

Current and Future Property Use

The Phase I Property is currently vacant.

It is our understanding that the Phase I Property is to be developed with a commercial development and associated asphaltic concrete parking lot. Since the land has never formally been developed, a record of site condition (RSC) will not be required to be filed with the MECP.

Neighbouring Land Use

The surrounding lands within the Phase I Study Area consist of a mix of residential and commercial retail properties. Current land use is depicted on Drawing PE6469-2 – Surrounding Land Use Plan, in the Figures section of this report.



Potentially Contaminating Activities and Areas of Potential Environmental Concern

As per Section 7.1 of the Phase I ESA report, no potentially contaminating activities (PCAs) or areas of potential environmental concern (APECs) were identified on the Phase I Property.

Six PCAs were identified with respect to off-site properties situated within the Phase I Study Area. Based on their hydraulically down- or cross-gradient orientation with respect to the anticipated groundwater flow to the north, the separation distances, these PCAs are not considered to pose an environmental concern to the Phase I Property.

Contaminants of Potential Concern

As per Section 7.1 of this report, no CPCs were identified on the Phase I Property.

Assessment of Uncertainty and/or Absence of Information

The information available for review as part of the preparation of this Phase I ESA is considered to be sufficient to conclude that there are no PCAs that have resulted in APECs on the Phase I Property.

The absence of any PCAs was confirmed by a variety of independent sources, and as such, the conclusions of this report are not affected by uncertainty which may be present with respect to the individual sources.



8.0 CONCLUSIONS

8.1 Assessment

Paterson Group was retained by Smartcentres acting on behalf of SmartREIT (Orleans II) Inc. & Mer Bleue Shopping Centres Limited to conduct a Phase I – Environmental Site Assessment (Phase I ESA) for Part of 2025 Mer Bleue Road, in the City of Ottawa, Ontario. The objective of this Phase I ESA was to research the past and current use of the site (Phase I Property) and 250m study area (Phase I Study Area) and to identify any environmental concerns with the potential to have impacted the subject property.

According to the historical research, the Phase I Property was never formally developed. The surrounding lands within the Phase I Study Area were developed with residential dwellings to the north of Innes Road circa 1991, with some commercial retail at the intersection of Innes and Mer Bleue Road. Further commercial retail development occurred in the early 2000s to the west. Several automotive dealerships were developed in the mid 2010s to the southwest of the Phase I ESA Property. The adjacent property to west was first developed 2018 with the current commercial retail plaza and associated parking. No potential environmental concerns were identified pertaining to the historical use of the Phase I Property and surrounding properties.

Presently, the Phase I Property is vacant with a seasonal storage building located at the southwest corner of the property, while the surrounding lands largely consist of a mix of residential to the north, and commercial retail properties, and poses no environmental concern to the Phase I Property.

8.2 Conclusion

Based on the findings of this assessment, it is our opinion that **a Phase II** – Environmental Site Assessment will not be required for the Phase I Property.



9.0 STATEMENT OF LIMITATIONS

This Phase I – Environmental Site Assessment report has been prepared in general accordance with O.Reg. 153/04, as amended, and meets the requirements of CSA Z768-01 (reaffirmed 2022). The conclusions presented herein are based on information gathered from a limited historical review and field inspection program. The findings of the Phase I ESA are based on a review of readily available geological, historical, and regulatory information as well as a cursory review made at the time of the field assessment. The historical research relies on information supplied by others, such as local, provincial, and federal agencies and was limited within the scope-of-work, time, and budget of the project herein.

Should any conditions be encountered at the Phase I Property and/or historical information that differ from our findings, we request that we be notified immediately in order to allow for a reassessment.

This report was prepared for the sole use of SmartREIT (Orleans II) Inc. & Mer Bleue Shopping Centres Limited. Permission and notification from the above noted parties and Paterson Group will be required prior to the release of this report to any other party.




FIGURE 1 KEY PLAN








FIGURE 2 TOPOGRAPHIC MAP


