



NOTES:

1. THE LOCATION OF UTILITIES IS APPROXIMATE ONLY, AND THE EXACT LOCATION SHOULD BE DETERMINED BY CONSULTING THE MUNICIPAL AUTHORITIES AND UTILITY COMPANIES CONCERNED. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING INFORMATION AND STATUS OF UTILITIES AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ADEQUATE PROTECTION OF PLANT AND EQUIPMENT FROM DAMAGE DURING SUCH TIME AS THE SERVICE PROVIDER HAS CONFIRMED IN WRITING THAT THE SERVICE IS ABANDONED AND CAN BE REMOVED. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING INFORMATION AND REPLACEMENT OF ANY SERVICES OR UTILITIES DISTURBED DURING CONSTRUCTION, TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE AUTHORITY HAVING JURISDICTION.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATION AND ELEVATION OF EXISTING SERVICES PRIOR TO ANY CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONFIRM LOCATIONS AND ELEVATIONS OF EXISTING SERVICES PRIOR TO COMMENCING CONSTRUCTION. ALL DIMENSIONS SHALL BE CHECKED AND VERIFIED BY THE CONTRACTOR PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION. ANY DISCREPANCIES, INTERPRETATIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS TO THESE DRAWINGS MUST BE BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE ENGINEER, WHEN NOTED AND BEFORE PROCEEDING WITH CONSTRUCTION WORKS. DO NOT COMMENCE CONSTRUCTION IN AREAS WHERE DISCREPANCIES APPEAR UNTIL SUCH DISCREPANCIES HAVE BEEN RESOLVED.
