RE: CEDAR HEDGE AT 290 PARK ROAD, ROCKCLIFFE

Dear [REDACTED],

Further to our site meeting on July 9th, this brief letter report provides a review of the cedar hedge located on either side of the driveway at the above noted address. The hedge runs parallel to Springfield Road and intersects the driveway where it crosses the city right of way.

The partial removal of the southern portion of the hedge to allow for the expansion of the driveway will have no impact on its health or character. The current lack of foliage indicates the hedge was previously cut back from the edge of the driveway. The further removal of up to 2m of hedge will result in a similar open appearance. However, the recommended placement of one or two new white cedars (*Thuja occidentalis*) and subsequent pruning of same into the hedge will allow it to develop an appearance similar to that of the northern edge (see pictures 1 and 2 on page 2).
